KEY MESSAGING

1. Elevate Alaska public lands. Illustrate the place, make people want to go there someday, understand it is worth protecting.

a. Alaska's public lands belong to all Americans.

b. Alaska is home to our country's most magnificent and vast unspoiled landscapes and abundant wildlife.

c. Alaska provides opportunities for world-class outdoor recreation, including backpacking, rafting, fishing, hunting and more.

d. Alaska's wild lands are a living testament to our country's last unspoiled places.

2. Articulate threat. The audience understands Alaska will be forever changed if we don't protect it from imminent threats and sell-offs.

a. Avoid specific issues or campaigns.

b. Alaska's public lands face increasing threats of permanent sell-off, cutting our last wild state up piece by piece until it is gone.

c. Alaska's Governor continues to cozy up to industries that propose overturning prime habitat for fish and wildlife and polluting the water. Beyond Alaska, federal officials look to betray American heritage by selling off Alaska's wildest public lands to the highest bidder for short-term profit and permanent loss.

3. Build engaged defense. Ensure that grassroots supporters nationwide understand their role in defending Alaska's public lands and waters.

a. Public lands in Alaska are priceless and magnificent beyond imagination.

b. Today's elected leaders are backing ideas to sell off Alaska to the highest bidders, often foreign-owned companies, to cover tax breaks for billionaires. They are prioritizing short-term profit that results in permanent loss of your American heritage and opportunity.

c. Protecting Alaska wild lands protects American heritage.

4. Call to Action. Not only does the audience understand what do to, but they have the tools to share with and mobilize their community.

 Schedule posts for the morning and early afternoon for higher visibility with media and political circles.


Instagram Posting Strategies

- Include polls and quizzes in Stories for engagement.
- Pin key stories with action links to Highlights.
- Do not include links in post copy, instead use bio links/Linktrees or include in bio.
- Incorporate hashtags into post copy.

Facebook Posting Strategies

- Can expand to post longer captions, or add links to full articles.
- Share within local groups when possible and encourage followers to share.
- For videos, upload directly instead of sharing YouTube links.
